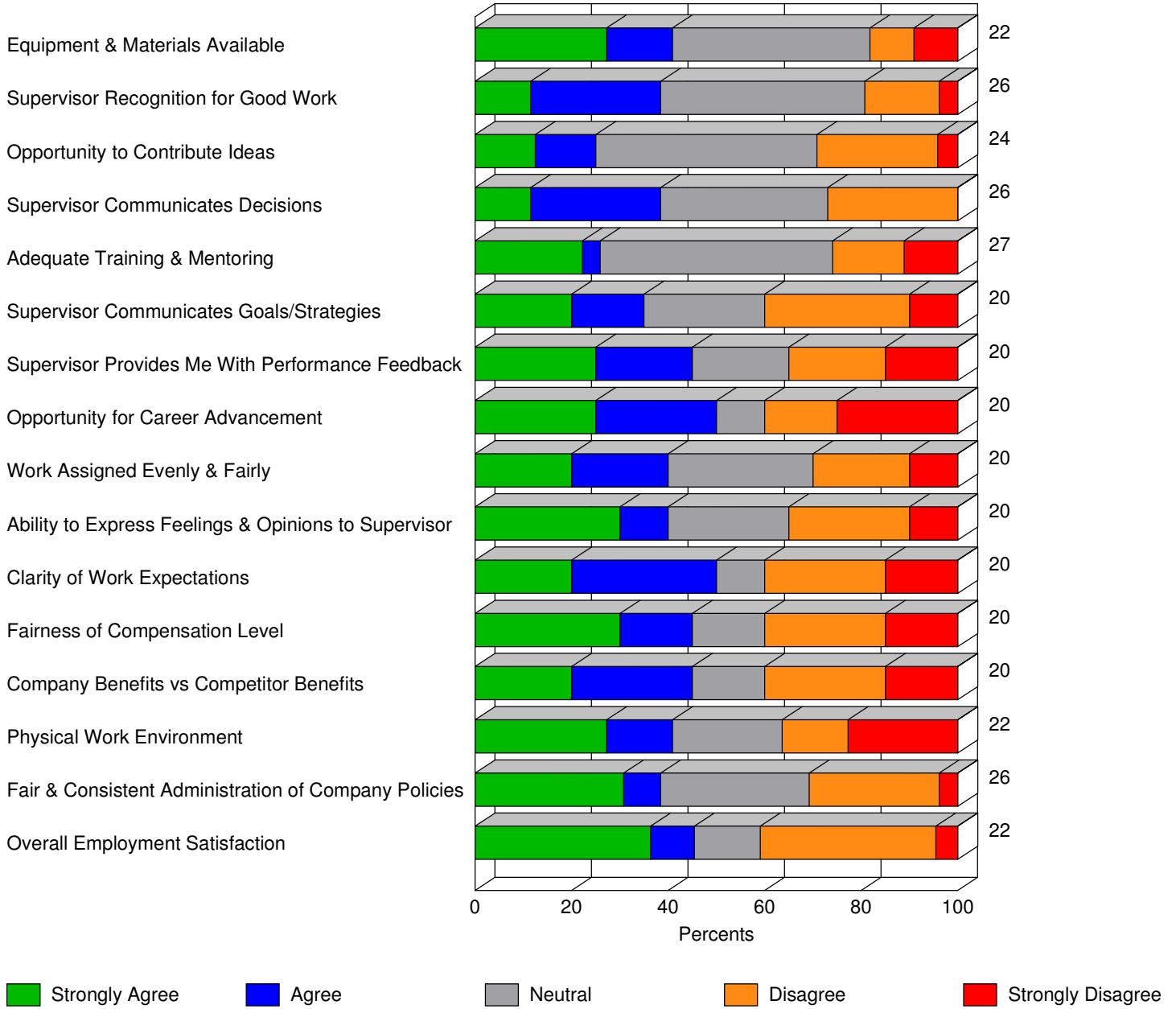

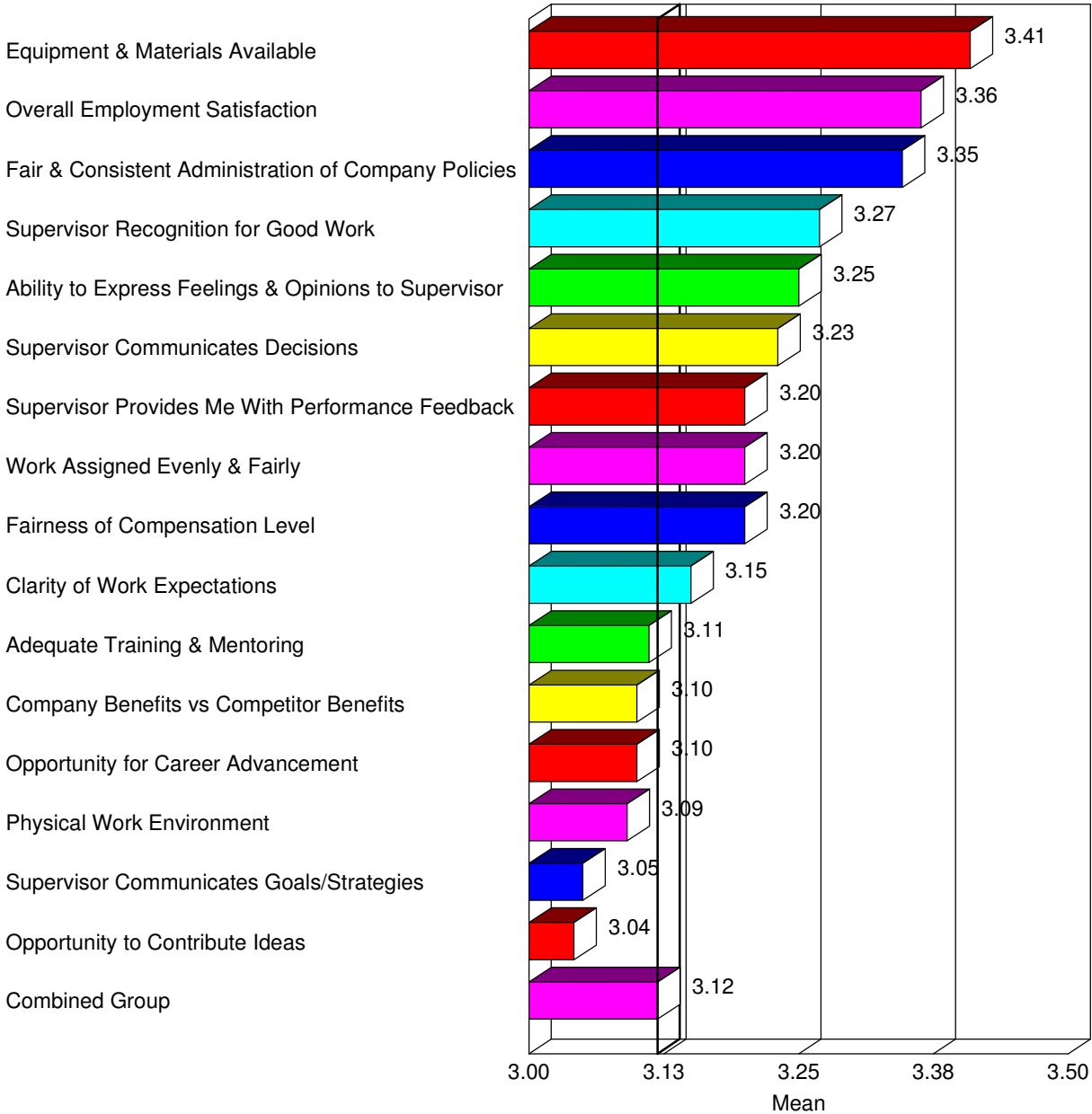
Stacked Bar Chart Responses (*Not Applicables Excluded*)

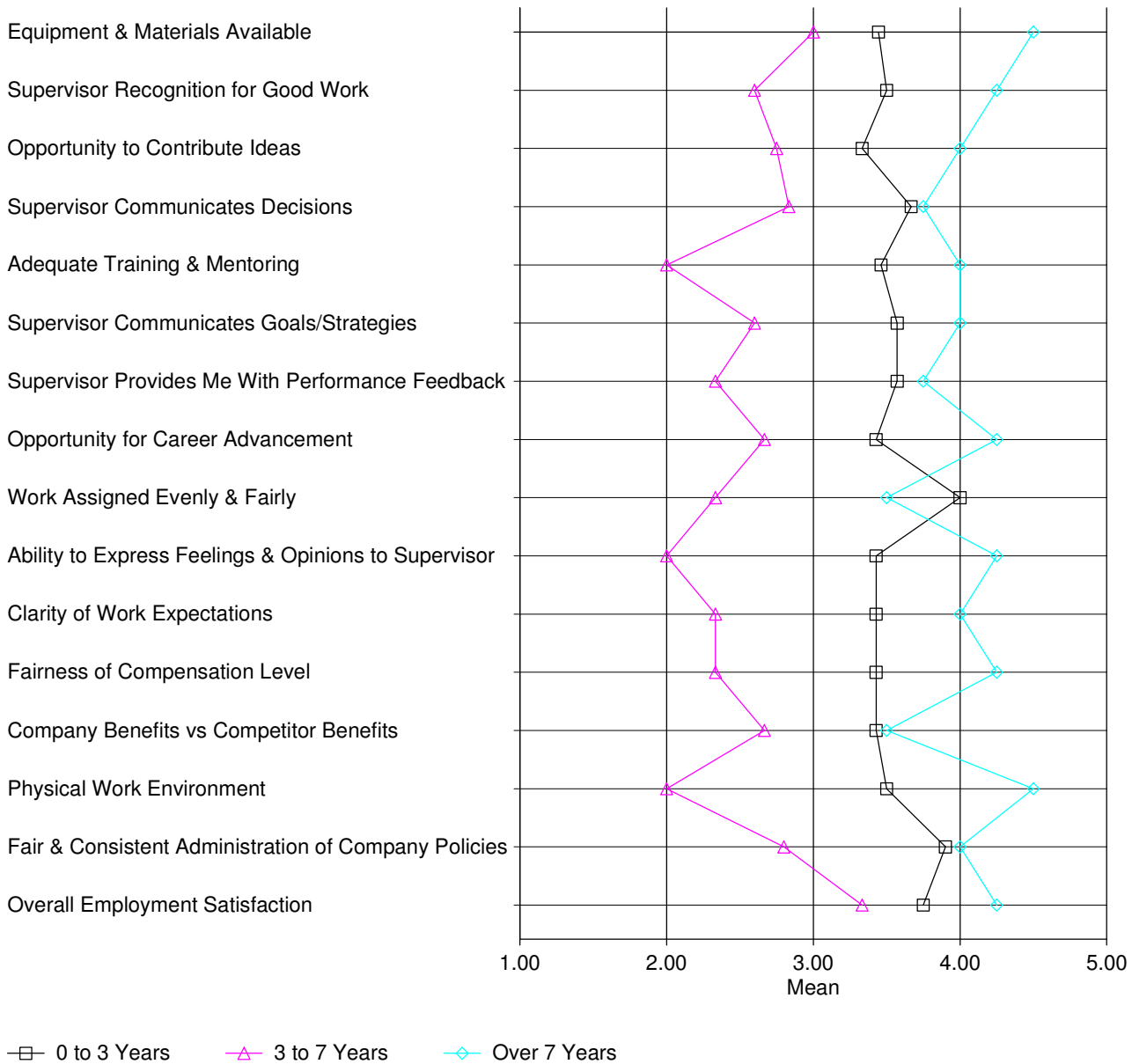
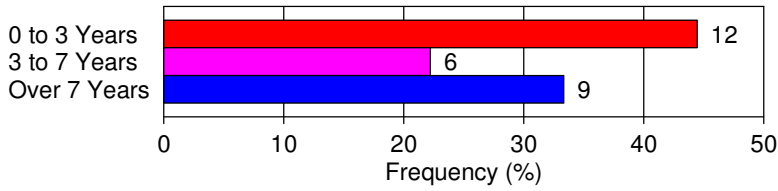


Score Comparison By Tenure

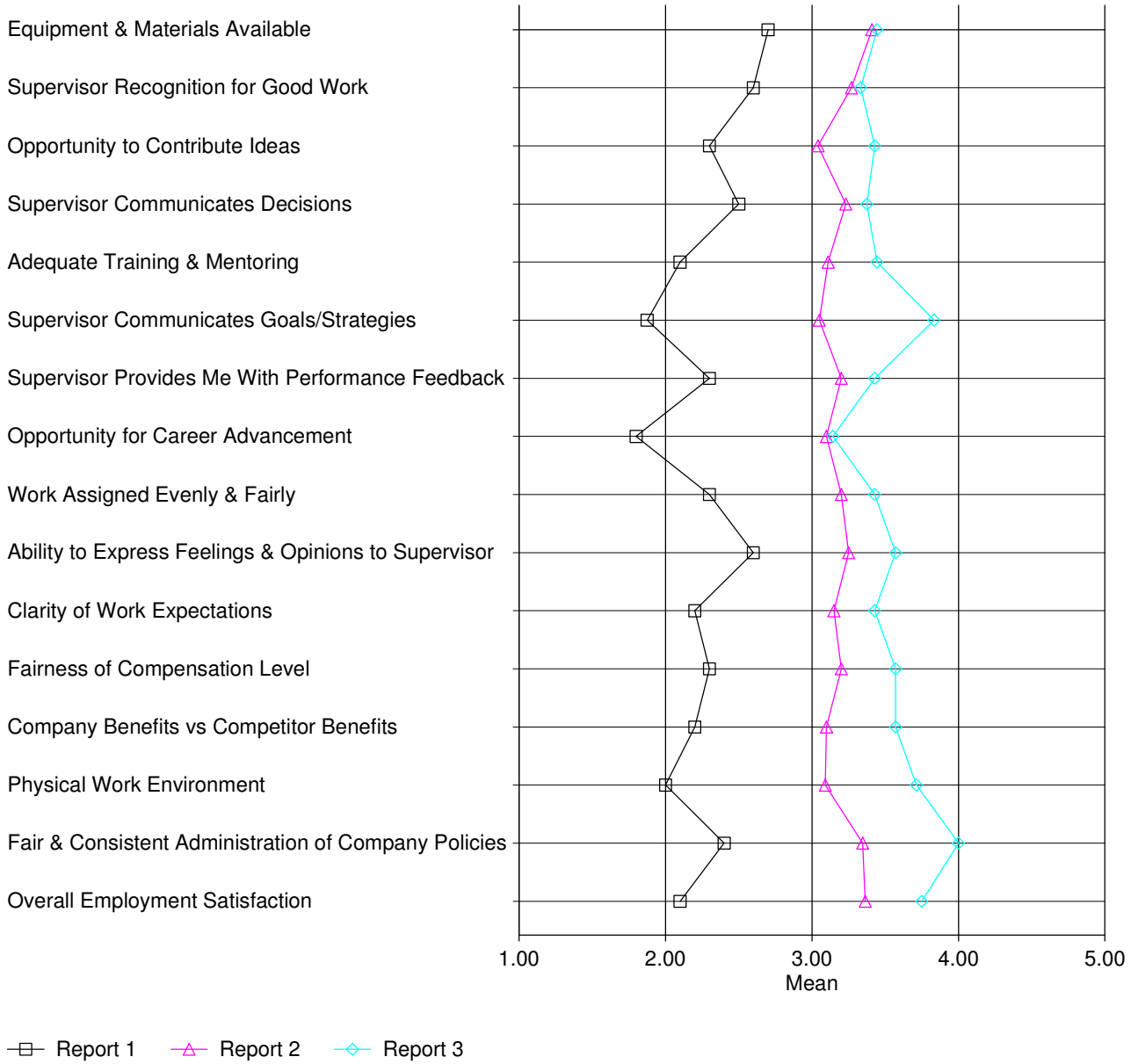

How long have you worked for the Sample Company?



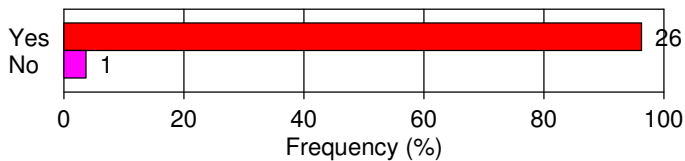
Report-To-Report Score Comparison
